



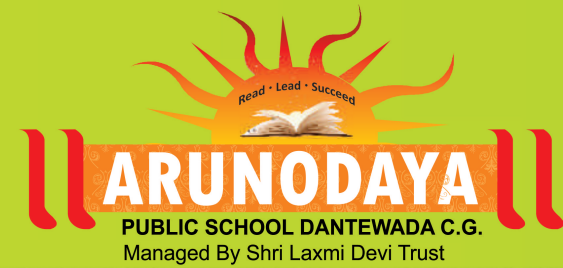

On behalf of all the staff of Arunodaya Public School, Dantewada—, I welcome you to our wonderful school.

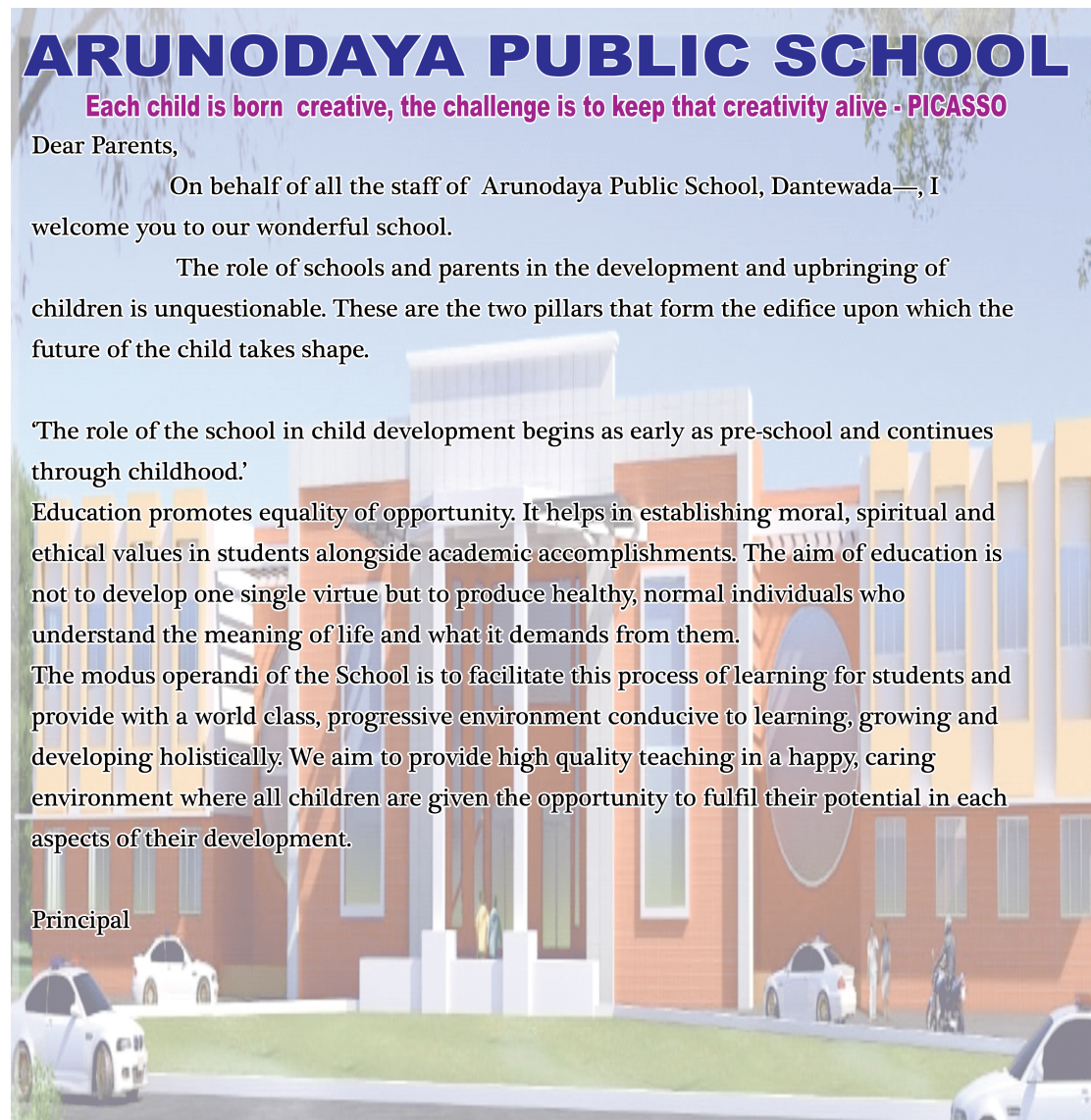
The role of schools and parents in the development and upbringing of children is unquestionable. These are the two pillars that form the edifice upon which the future of the child takes shape.

Primary School

The expectations for excellence in primary education have dramatically changed over the last decade. Today's world requires children to grow up to become critical thinkers and problem solvers. Therefore, students must not only be academically proficient, but also capable of adapting their classroom learning to real-life situations. Here at Arunodaya—, we have skilfully bridged the gap between learning and real-world experience through a challenging and accelerated curriculum in a dedicated small classroom environment—fewer than 30 students—that allows our programmes to be tailored to the unique needs of every student.

Mathematics—Emphasis on concrete concepts, quantitative reasoning and problem-solving

Language Arts—Instruction in comprehension skills, writing skills, spelling and grammar, including grade appropriate research papers and oral presentations

Accelerated Reader—Development for independent reading

Science—Concentration on concept formation, observational accuracy and recording scientific data

Social Studies—Utilisation of community resources, respect for ways in which to meet the country's challenges and preparation to become responsible citizens Critical Thinking skills are integrated into every lesson in all grades. Technology

is an integral part of our programme with instruction in our state-of-the-art computer lab, though laptops and SMART Board™ Interactive classrooms, all of which are used throughout the curriculum.

Middle School

Arunodaya Public School brings together enthusiastic, caring teachers and a dynamic and collaborative atmosphere in its goal of educating early adolescents. With generally 35 students each in Classes 6, 7 and 8, the Middle School offers a personal, integrated and exciting programme, creating a community of learners in which young people feel comfortable taking intellectual risks and growing both as students and individuals.

Students in our Middle School will find their days filled with stimulating classes, exciting labs, playful interactions, and artistic discovery. In addition to their core lessons, students in Classes 6, 7, and 8 take year long visual arts and performing arts courses. At various times during their Middle School years, students will be involved in seminars and semester courses including drama, media literacy, health and wellness, human development and leadership training. At the end of the academic day, students participate in our athletic programme, which provides continued development of teamwork, skill and perseverance through a number of interscholastic and some intramural sports.
